## QUEEN OF HEARTS HILLSBORO ELKS 1862 GAME GUIDELINES

- Any Elk Member/Spouse/Widow is eligible to participate. You MUST be in good standing and able to produce your current membership card or signed receipt showing and proving that you are a member in good standing at the time of your ticket purchase and at the time your ticket is drawn.
- If the purchaser is unable to produce the above, they will be unable to purchase tickets or draw a card for that week's game.
- In the event we have no winner because of invalid membership status, that ticket will be discarded, and we will pull another ticket.
- Members are responsible for writing their name, phone number, and Queen of Hearts board number on each ticket. Only one name may be on the ticket. Blank tickets or tickets with information that is not legible will be discarded, and another ticket will be drawn.
- The Queen of Hearts raffle is a bi-weekly raffle with a progressive jackpot. Tickets are sold daily, \$5 each or 5 for \$20. Tickets can be purchased from the bartender on duty or a committee member. All purchases must be made with cash. Tickets can be purchased daily up to 5:50 pm on Wednesday and 3:50 pm on Sunday. The drawings will be on Wednesdays at 6 pm and Sundays at 4 pm. After each drawing, all tickets will be discarded. New tickets will be available for next week's drawings.
- You do not need to be present to win. At each drawing, a committee member (or someone selected by the committee) will draw a ticket from the tumbler. A committee member will open and announce the selected card.
- As a progressive raffle, after each drawing, the pot will increase without limit. 50% of ticket sales will be added to the pot, the remaining 50% will be divided, with a portion going to funding the next game, a charity recipient of the committee's choice, and the balance to the committee for supplies.
- 54 cards (52 Standard cards and 2 Jokers) come preloaded sealed board. A committee member will cut out the selected card it will then be put back on the board with the card facing out.
- Any single raffle game can last no longer than 52 weeks. There will be a total of 30,000 tickets available for sale.

## Prizes for game cards are as follows:

Queen of Hearts – Jackpot! (cash portion of payout will be by appointment within 5 business, gift card portion payout within 14 business days of winning)

Per Oregon law, the maximum cash allowed to be paid out is \$5000 (per game); the balance will be in gift cards/certificates. Fees for any cards will be passed on to the winner. The jackpot winner will have one week to let the committee know what gift cards/denominations they would like for their winnings. A game is defined as drawing until the Queen of Hearts is drawn.

It is your responsibility to read and understand these rules. By purchasing tickets, you agree to these rules. In all matters regarding this game, the decision of the Queen of Hearts Committee, Exalted Ruler, Trustees, and the Board of Directors, is final. No exceptions.
