Registration & Donations

- **Eligibility:** RV parking is for Elk members in good standing. Members may sponsor **one** non-member RV and are responsible for their guests.
- **Check-In:** All guests must register with the lodge bartender immediately upon arrival. A current membership card must be presented. Bartenders are available after 2 PM Monday and Tuesday, 1 PM Wednesday, 11 AM Thursday through Saturday, and 9 AM Sunday.
- **Check-Out:** 1:00 PM.
- **Availability:** First-come, first-served. No advanced reservations.
- **Suggested Donations:**
 - **Hook-up Sites:** \$25/night. Prepayment is required.
 - **Dry Camping:** \$10/night. Prepayment is required.
(72-hour limit and **only** available if full hook-up sites are occupied).

Duration of Stay

- **14-Day Limit:** Maximum stay is 14 consecutive days (including dry camping days).
- **Reset Period:** After 14 days, the RV must leave the property for at least **2 consecutive days**. No more than 30 consecutive days are allowed in any 60-day period.
- **Return Policy:** Re-entry after a 14-day stay requires Board approval.

General Rules & Conduct

- **Permits:** Display your parking permit in a window visible from the outside or near the main vehicle entrance.
- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
- **Alcohol:** Consumption is strictly prohibited outside of the lodge building.
- **Prohibited Behavior:** Rowdiness, loud music, abusive language, public drunkenness, and possession or use of illegal drugs is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate permanent eviction.
- **Children:** Parents are responsible for children (under 18) at all times. Children must be inside their RV or at their site by 9:00 PM, must wear helmets when cycling, and may not be left unattended.
- **Posted Rules:** All signs, posted notices, and directions of the Board will be obeyed. Noncompliance may result in immediate loss of parking privileges.

- **Weapons:** All weapons shall be kept in compliance with all applicable state and federal laws.

Vehicle & Site Requirements

- **Condition:** Vehicles must be in good repair, self-contained, and aesthetically well-kept (no tarps or excessive damage). All vehicles must enter under their own power and be ready to move if needed. Vehicles may be inspected for hazardous or safety concerns prior to acceptance.
- **Parking:** Back into the center of your space. Slide-outs and awnings must stay within your assigned area.
- **No Open Fires:** No propane, wood, or other fire pits are allowed.
- **Site Maintenance:** Keep sites neat. No tent camping or sleeping in passenger vehicles.
- **Waste, Water & Trash:** No discharge of water (gray or black) nor RV washing is permitted on-site; violation results in immediate permanent eviction. Trash receptacles are located by the receiving dock of the lodge for your convenience and must always remain closed. If water rationing becomes mandatory by the city, county or state, you will be informed.

Pet Policy

- **Control:** Pets must be on a leash or contained within the RV at all times. Portable pet fences are not allowed. Any other animal different than dogs or cats requires advance permission from the camp host and Hillsboro Elks Lodge No. 1862 Board of Directors.
- **Cleanup:** Waste must be picked up immediately and disposed of in the trash.
- **Liability:** Owners are 100% liable for their pets, including injury, destruction, and annoyances to other guests. Dangerous dogs are not permitted; any injury caused by a pet will result in immediate permanent eviction.

Legal Notice: Hillsboro Elks Lodge No. 1862 is private property. We reserve the right to refuse service or evict anyone for policy violations, property damage, or disturbances. The lodge is not responsible for fire, theft, injury, or loss of personal property. The Hillsboro Elks Lodge shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or injury of any kind whatsoever caused by a guest's pet. No illegal activities are allowed on Elk property. Any evidence of this will result in immediate eviction.
